

Full Terms and Conditions:

The competition opens on **Saturday 1st August 2026** and closes at on **6:00pm on Saturday 12th September 2026**. Entries received after the closing time will not be included. The competition is open to UK residents aged 18 or over.

To enter, participants must complete the official entry form at <https://duncanmurraywines.co.uk/duncan-murray-wines-25th-anniversary/> , including their contact details and suggested beer name.

Entrants may submit one beer name. Each suggested name must not exceed 5 words, must be the entrant's own original idea and must not contain offensive or inappropriate language or copy an existing beer, product or brand name.

The winning name will be chosen by representatives from Duncan Murray Wines and Braybrooke Brewery based on its originality, relevance and suitability for the beer. If the same winning name is submitted by more than one person, the first eligible entry received will be selected as the winner.

The winner will receive **a 24-bottle case of the winning beer and a VIP tour and tasting at Braybrooke Brewery** and will be contacted by **phone and email** within **5** days of the closing date. They must respond within **8** days; otherwise, another winner may be selected.

The prize is non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash. The winner must be able to **collect the case of beer from Duncan Murray Wines**. Valid photographic identification may be required.

The winning beer name may be used and adapted by Duncan Murray Wines and Braybrooke Brewery for the beer, its packaging and promotional materials. No additional payment or royalties will be provided beyond the stated prize.

The personal details submitted through the entry form will only be used to administer the competition and contact the winner. Entrants will only receive marketing communications if they separately choose to sign up.
